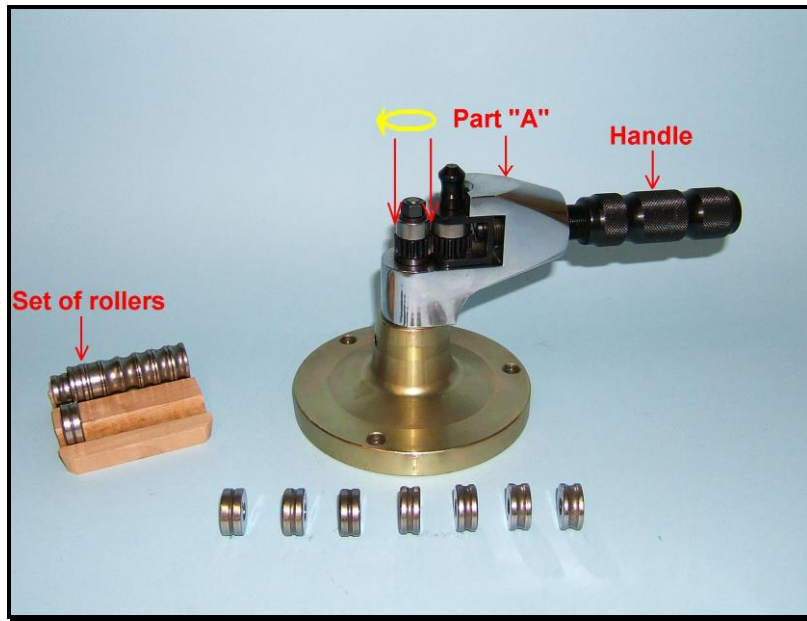


OMO Stone-set ring stretcher # 35/AN



Our ringstretcher easily enlarges gem-set rings without the removal of the stone. It comes with a set of 16 dies in a plastic storage box + 2 already mounted on the stretcher.

Two of these rollers are channelled for flat shanks.
It can be used on plain wedding rings too.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For a easier use, you have to secure the ring stretcher to your work bench through the 3 holes of the base, by using long screws (not supplied).

- Depending on the shape and size of the shank of the ring you want to stretch, choose the die that fits the best.
- In order to fit this die into the stretcher, pull out the black holding pin on the top and you will see that the die and the gear nearest to the open/closing handle can be removed.
- Place the selected die on top of the gear and lock it with the holding pin.
- Put your ring (with the stone outside) around the centre part of the ring stretcher, as showed in the picture above.
- Approach the part "A" to the ring, by turning the handle clockwise until the rollers meet both sides of the ring.
- If you now move the handle backwards and forwards, you will make some pressure on the shank of the ring, thus it will expand.
- You can repeat the process in case you have not reached the desired size, by choosing another die that fits.
